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- The UF Health Flagler Hospital Hurricane Plan is based severity categories. For any hurricane condition, the goal of the hurricane plan is to provide a safe environment for patients, staff and property.

| Hurricane Severity Categories | | |
|-------------------------------|-------------|--------------|
| Category | Winds (MPH) | Damage |
| 1 | 74 - 95 | Minimal |
| 2 | 96 - 110 | Moderate |
| 3 | 111 - 130 | Extensive |
| 4 | 131 - 155 | Extreme |
| 5 | 155 + | Catastrophic |

UF Health Flagler Hospital Hurricane Plan: Category 1 & Category 2 Storms

Hurricane Plan Goals for Category 1 and Category 2 Storms:

- Continue medical treatment and care as long as environmental conditions allow and essential services are available
- Secure workplace area, safely reduce patient census and reduce staffing where possible
- Directors will verify staff scheduled to work during the storm by name and will prepare lists for the Incident Commander utilizing the Planned Emergency Response Team (PERT) team list
